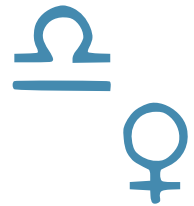


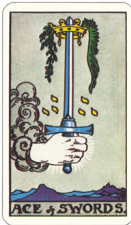
Libra: 1 Balance

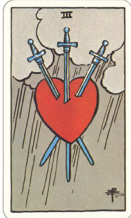

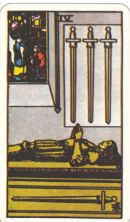

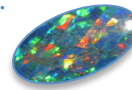

The opal, Libra's birthstone, is the stone of love, purity, and hope. The ancients believed it gave the owner the gift of prophecy. The idea that opals can only be born by someone born during the month of October is a recent one, not rooted in ancient beliefs.

It was called "Cupid's Stone" by the Romans who believed it had aphrodisiacal qualities.

Libra is associated with the the loving number 6 ~ sharing, family, and community. It is also associated with the number of partnering and union, 2.

The Empress (Venus) is associated with creativity, love, and pleasure. Justice (Libra), scales in hand, weighs all things to bring them into balance. Together, The Empress and Justice, allow us to use both our head and our hearts in right proportion.



Owls are symbols of Libra's wisdom. They were the totem animal of Athena, goddess of wisdom, justice, arts, and crafts. Animals who use their tails for balance include the kangaroo, squirrel, and the cougar.



The glyph for Venus is reminiscent of a hand mirror, one of the goddesses favorite items. The glyph for Libra represents a scale in perfect balance. Joanna Martine Woolfolk says that it's an "ancient Egyptian symbol for the setting sun." The placement of the setting sun is noted by the cusp of the 7th house of a natal chart.
